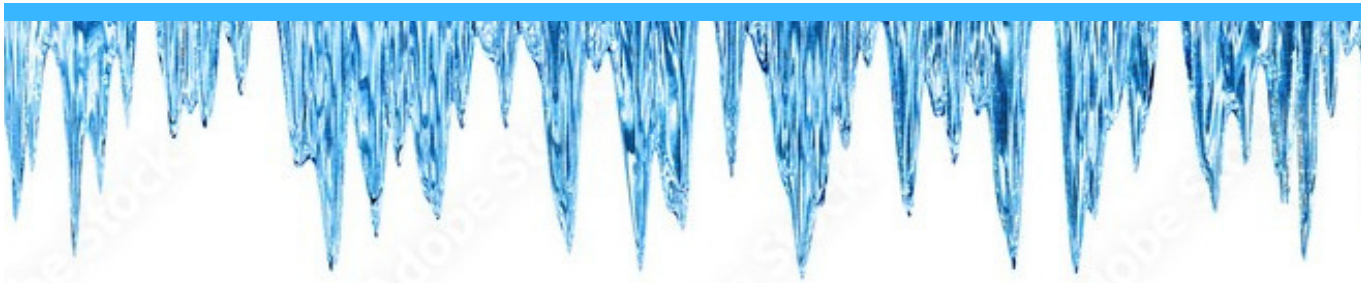

»»» COLD WEATHER HOME SAFETY

- January is a great time to review your **Home Safety Equipment and its use!**
 - **Check:**
 - **Fire extinguishers**
 - At least one on each floor of your home, plus kitchen and garage.
 - Check for expiration date.
 - **Carbon monoxide detectors**
 - Test
 - Especially important near sleeping areas!
 - **Smoke detectors**
 - Up to date, working, and placed on all floors of your home.





- Have your chimney cleaned and checked for obstructions before enjoying those fabulous fires on cold evenings.
- Be sure the flue is open! (We've all made *that* mistake!)

- To avoid frozen hose bibs and pipes, install outdoor faucet insulators and turn off water supply to outdoor faucets where able. (Inexpensive at your local home or hardware store or online.)



➤➤➤ ANOTHER REMINDER ABOUT MAINTAINING SNOW AND ICE-FREE SIDEWALKS. * LEGALLY REQUIRED BY THE VILLAGE OF ALGONQUIN * FAILURE TO DO SO MAY RESULT IN A FINE FROM THE VILLAGE!



Algonquin Village Code: “Snow and Ice must be removed from sidewalks in front of (our Glenmoor properties) within 24 hours after any snowfall has ceased. If snow or ice cannot be removed, the surface shall be sanded or otherwise treated to lessen the hazard for pedestrians until climate permits removal”

>>> GROOT WILL HAUL AWAY YOUR YOUR (LIVE) CHRISTMAS TREE FREE OF CHARGE THROUGHOUT JANUARY!

- o No sticker required.
- o Trees must be free of all decoration.
- o Do not place trees in plastic bags.
- o Trees over 6 ft. tall must be cut in half.
- o Trees must be easily accessible to Groot workers and must not be buried in the snow.

Judi's 7 Tips for Safe Gardening This Spring

1. **Warm up** before gardening. Walk around your garden for a few minutes, stretch and determine what you might tackle today.
2. **Wear gloves** when working outside to protect your hands against cuts, soil, insect bites, and skin irritants.
3. Rest frequently, **drink plenty of water** (bring it outside with you), and wear sunscreen if you are fair-skinned.
4. **Avoid long gardening sessions** or uncomfortable positions.
5. **Rotate tasks** to avoid repetitive movements, for example, after 30 minutes of raking, swap to pruning for a while.
6. In the **cold follow the sun**, in the **heat follow the shade** as you garden.
7. Check posture. **Using knee pads** instead of bending puts less strain on your back.
