


## **NOTABLE DATES IN MARCH**

## DID YOU KNOW? MARCH WAS NAMED AFTER THE ROMAN GOD OF WAR, MARS

- March 10 Daylight Saving Time begins at 2:00 A.M. Sunday. Don't forget to "SPRING FORWARD" and set the clocks one hour ahead, or you may find yourself an hour LATE for... EVERYTHING!
- March 17 St. Patrick's Day 🎇
- March 19 The March Equinox also called the vernal or spring equinox in the Northern Hemisphere marking the beginning of SPRING!
- March 23 Algonquin Egg Hunt
  - Algonquin Lakes Park, 700 Lake Plumleigh Way, Algonquin
    - Photos with the Easter Bunny 9:30 to 10:30. Egg Hunt begins at 10.
- March 25 The "Worm Moon"
  - The only full moon in March 2024
- March 31 Easter Sunday
  - Have you wondered why Easter Sunday is on a different date each year?
    - Easter falls on the first Sunday AFTER the full moon which occurs on or after March 21.
      - In 2024, Easter Sunday falls on the first Sunday after the Worm Moon.
- Average March snowfall in the Chicago area:










It's 2/11/24, have you noticed the **Daffodils** popping up on IVY street?


