- Oct. 5 Algonquin Harvest Market 10AM to 4PM
  - Artisans, Farmers Market, Entertainment, Food and Drinks, Give-a-ways, and MORE!
    - Main Street Historic Downtown Algonquin
- Oct. 14 Columbus Day
  - A Federal Holiday in the United States, which officially celebrates the anniversary of Christopher Columbus's arrival in the Americas. Columbus went ashore at Guanahaní, an island in the Bahamas, on October 12, 1492.
    - Typically, Govt. Employees have the day off. Banks, Post office and some schools close. (Check YOUR school schedule!)
- Oct. 19 Sweetest Day
  - A day to show love and appreciation to the people who matter to you most.
    - It is also the perfect day to do some charity work or help out people in need.
- Oct. 19 Trick or Treat Trail Old Town, Algonquin, Main St. 4pm to 6 PM

  - Kiddos, don't forget to wear your costumes!
- Oct. 31 Halloween! Trick or Treating 3pm to 7pm (Click HERE for a SPOOKY history of Halloween!)

# >>> A Little Glenmoor Business...

#### **GROOT** will provide the **FREE COLLECTION** of **LEAVES** and **BRUSH** from October 3 through December 13.

- Leaves must be placed in standard paper yard waste bags or cans that are clearly marked with a RED "X". Brush must be tied in 4ft. bundles.
  - Leaves in loose piles WILL NOT be collected.
  - DO NOT BLOW LEAVES ON TO GLENMOOR PUBLIC STREETS!
    - Doing so is a VIOLATION of Village Ordinance with possible fines and allows your leaves to be wind-blown on to neighboring properties, thus creating extra yard work for your neignbors.
- Bagged lawn clippings along with other general yard waste are not included and must be placed at the curb separately from bagged leaves and bundled brush on collection day.
  - Requires the use of prepaid stickers.



Groot Trash pick up -THURSDAYS throughout Oct.

Per VILLAGE ORDINANCE, do not leave empty trash cans in front of homes, garages, or in locations visible from the street following pickup.

# Do you have LARGE ITEMS, APPLIANCES or **CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS to dispose of?**

- Contact Groot East by calling 847-734-6400 to arrange for Special **Collection.** (These items will not be picked up with normal collection.)
- Place special collection items at the curb by 6 a.m. on your arranged and scheduled special collection day.
  - Please avoid leaving these special items in front of garages, curbside, or in any visible location until the night before your Special Collection is scheduled.

# **Village of Algonquin Winter Parking Regulations** Oct. 31- April 15

No Street Parking 2am - 5am or after snowfall of 2" or more. Schedule Limited overnight parking online or by contacting the Algonquin Police Department at (847) 658-4531.

Each residence is limited to five parking requests per month.
