GROOT FREE COLLECTION of LEAVES and BRUSH CONTIUNUES! through December 15.

- Leaves must be placed in standard paper yard waste bags or cans that are clearly marked with a RED "X".
- Brush must be tied in 4 ft. or shorter bundles.
 - Bagged lawn clippings along with other general yard waste are not included as free collection, must be placed separately from bagged leaves and bundled branches and will require the use of prepaid stickers.
- PLEASE! Do not blow leaves on to streets.
