For those who love working outdoors, there is a wealth of economical self-service lawn care information, product, and advice awaiting you at any local big box or hardware store.


By maintaining your property, you will be in compliance with the HOA Covenants. Section VI, Section 8 – Landscaping.

#### 🍟 Getting Started Is Easy

#### 1. Container Tips

- Ensure good drainage by drilling three to five holes if plastic container.
- Costco sells large pots for \$20.
- Use cans or capped bottles for the bottom half of the pot. It helps with drainage, need less soil, and makes large pots lighter and easier to move. For more details view this video.
- 2. Use the Right Soil: Buy a quality potting mix. Don't use garden soil—it's too heavy and may contain bugs or diseases.

#### 3. Pick Your Plants

- 🐉 Flowers: Marigolds, petunias, impatiens, geraniums
- Herbs: Basil, mint, parsley, chives, rosemary, oregano
- **Example 2** Veggies: Cherry tomatoes, peppers, lettuce, kale, spinach
- **ornamentals**: Ferns, grasses and succulents
- 4. Water & Feed Regularly: Containers dry out quickly. Water when soil feels dry 1 inch deep. Add a liquid fertilizer every 2-4 weeks for best results.

#### O Common Pitfalls to Avoid

- Forgetting to water on hot days
- Using containers that are too small
- Overwatering (watch for soggy soil)
- Mixing plants with different care needs
- Whether you want a splash of color, fresh herbs for cooking, or a mini tomato harvest, it's all possible with a few containers and a little care! 🔮
